

DEDICATION OF THE NEW HOME FOR DISABLED CHILDREN

The construction of the new home for children with special needs has now been completed!

The home was inaugurated on 26 August. On this special occasion, we invited Pastors and Leaders, families and local

representatives to attend the inauguration ceremony. We are grateful to all our dedicated partners who have been part of this remarkable project!

A few years ago, we took on the challenge of providing support and care for children with physical disabilities. This initiative was a big challenge for us as we had never started such a project before. By the grace of God and the support of dedicated friends, we embarked on this project. There were many obstacles along the way, the biggest being the lockdown due to the COVID pandemic.

This home will accommodate 65 children with various disabilities, both girls and boys. It will provide essential

services such as food, clothing, shelter, education and training, while promoting equal opportunities for disabled children. EWM | SPECIAL ISSUE DECEMBER 2024



physiotherapy and the love and support they truly deserve.

You can also provide a wheelchair or a medical equipment like a bed for a child with physical disability and improve his/her life.

• Cost for a wheelchair: \$285

Cost for a medical bed: \$380

It is vital not only for the child, but also for the family or care giver, as it helps to ease the stress and difficulties associated with bringing in a disabled child.













MISSION TO INDIA 2024

Our recent trip to India was an awesome experience. Eternal Word Ministries under the leadership of Pastor John Rajiah is doing a tremendous job in advancing the Kingdom of God in the nation of India and Nepal.

Our team witnessed first-hand the compassion and love Pastor John shows towards his fellow human beings. Pastor John is being led by the Holy Spirit and he operates in the spirit of excellence just like the prophet Daniel in the bible.

Pastor John and his team feeds lepers, provides medical care for them and also shares the Gospel. We were a part of his team during our

recent visit to the leper's colony; it's an amazing work of God. Additionally, Pastor John has a mobile eye clinic that provides eye care and glasses to thousands of villagers in remote areas. This is truly a labor of love and a vision the Lord has placed on the heart of Pastor John. We also had an opportunity to visit a local village where EWM drilled a bore-well that provides life giving water to hundreds of people. Over 400 wells have been drilled since the inception of EWM as well as over 402 churches planted.

EWM is a blessing to the nations that provides food, clothing, housing and education to 1200 orphans. All the work Pastor John and his wife Catherine does is by faith, no social service programs in India or Nepal. "My name is **Bhuvaneshwari**. I'm twenty years old. I come from a poor background. I could not go to school, but I always wished to study and have a good education.

Through a pastor who knows my family, I joined EWM children's home then I was able to study. I have completed my education up to 12th standard and am currently in my third year of Bachelor of Science in Chemistry at an Arts and Science College.

I really enjoyed my stay at EWM Children's Home. I come from a background where it was difficult to find food at home. But when I stayed at the EWM Children's Home, I was so well fed that I did not know what hunger was. Every year at Christmas, we had a show with dances and songs, and we received gifts and a tasty Christmas meal. I've also made a lot of friends there. It's also where I came to know Jesus as my Lord and Savior in my life. I will always cherish those sweet memories.

I would like to express my sincere gratitude to all the Leaders of EWM and my sponsors for providing me with free food and accommodation and for protecting me."



"My name is **Sowmiya** and I am 20. My father died when I was young. My mother works for daily wages. My family conditions were very poor and I was not able to go to school.

My mother heard about EWM Children's Home, and she took me there. I was able to go to school and I passed all my school exams with very good marks. I am very grateful for the education I received and for all the good advice and safe environment I benefited from during my stay. I will treasure these memories forever. Now I am working and I have a good income to be able to support myself and my family."






80% of India's rural population depend on groundwater for their domestic needs.*

Access to drinking water remains a challenge for rural communities in India. Families and their animals need water. which means that people, mainly women and children, must walk miles and miles to fetch water. In doing so, they have less time to devote to their work, which reduces the amount of money they could earn.

By drilling wells, EWM's drilling program gives families access to water in their village or close to their home. This improves their quality of life and saves time.

Another important aspect of this program is that when children have access to drinking water close to home, they can walk to school instead of fetching water. Access to drinking water made an enormous difference, not only for the children, but for all the community.








MISSION TO INDIA 2024





The consequences of menstrual insecurity on young women and their education, especially in the most rural areas of India, are a hindrance to their personal development.

The result is shame, lack of self-confidence and feelings of inferiority in a country where talking about this subject is still taboo, not to mention the health problems it can cause.

Many of these girls are unable to attend school because they do not have adequate means to manage their menstruation.

The aim of this program is to explain to these young girls how the female body works and why they have periods. We also give to each of them a pink bag containing two pairs of underwear, a pack of 6 reusable sanitary pads and a waterproof pouch.

These programs have been very successful. Girls and women come together and listen with great interest to the advice and practical information given.
